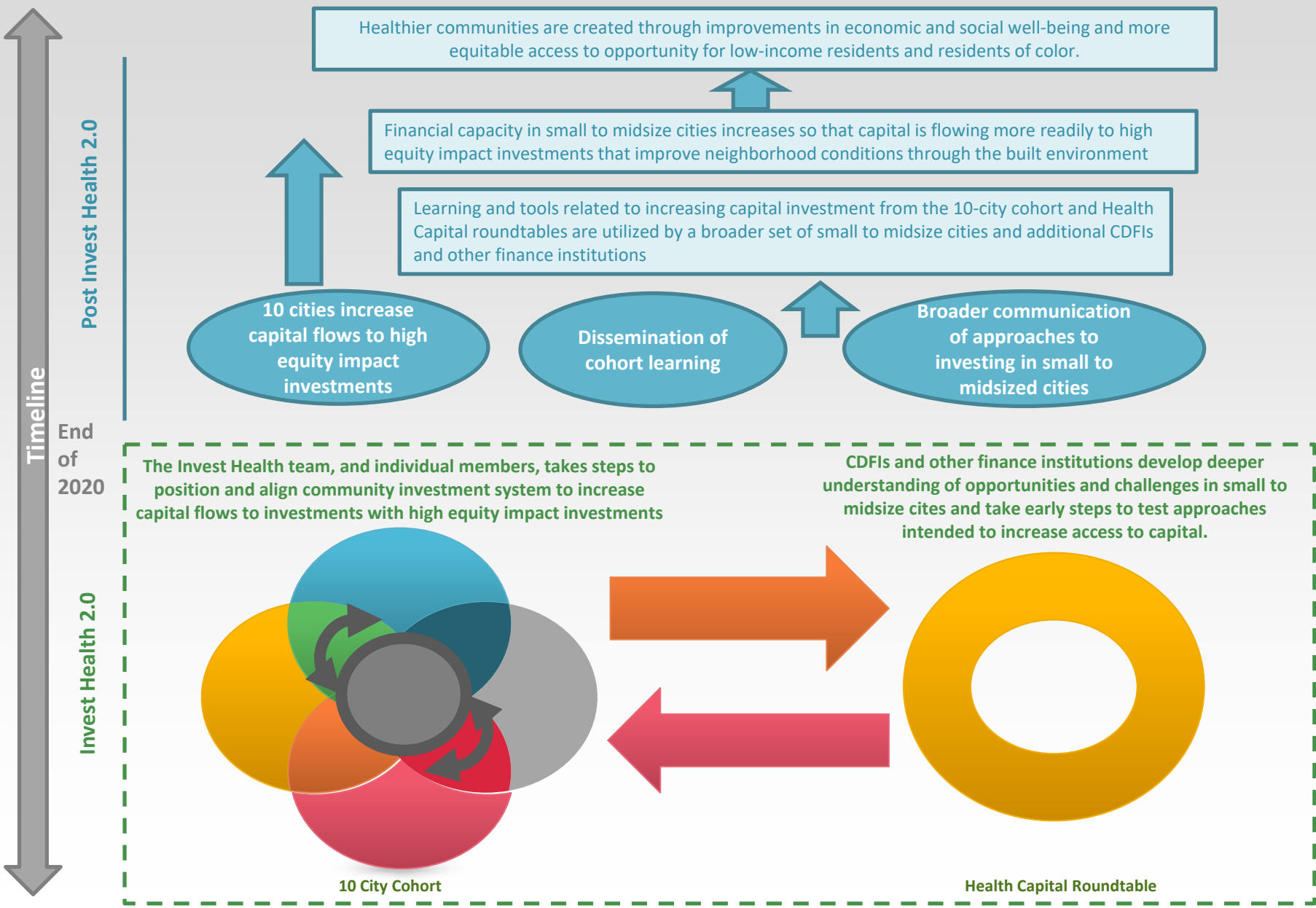

Invest Health 2.0: Connection between City Cohort and Health Capital Roundtable

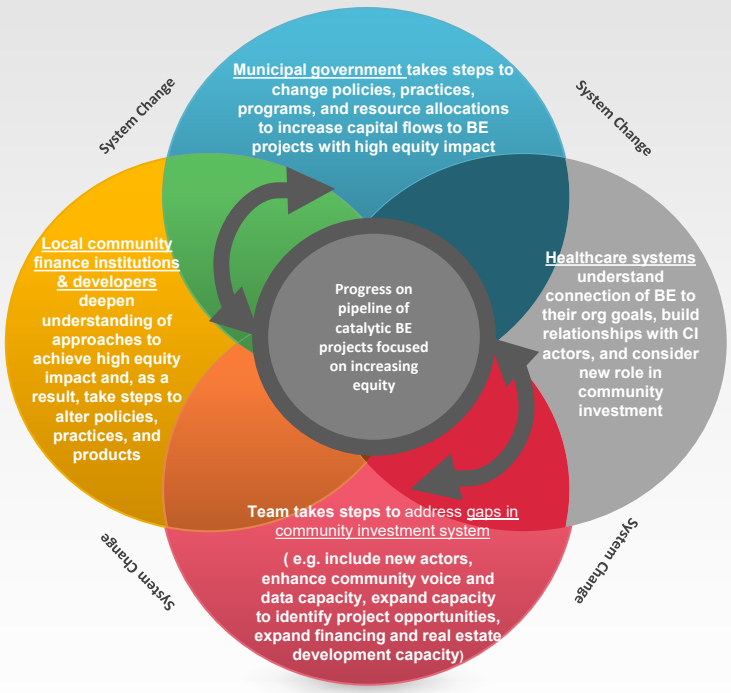
The Invest Health team, and individual members, takes steps to position and align community investment system to increase capital flows to investments with high equity impact investments

CDFIs and other finance institutions develop deeper understanding of opportunities and challenges in small to midsize cities and take early steps to test approaches intended to increase access to capital.

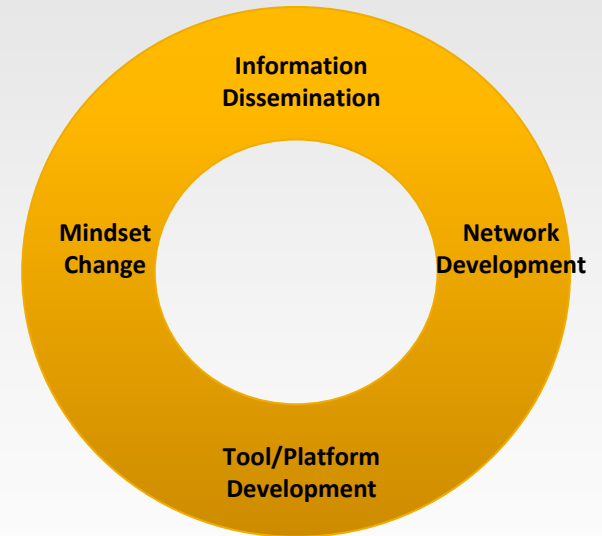


Understanding of barriers, opportunities to community investment with high equity impact in small to midsize cities

Teams will advance a system change agenda involving at least one of the categories below:

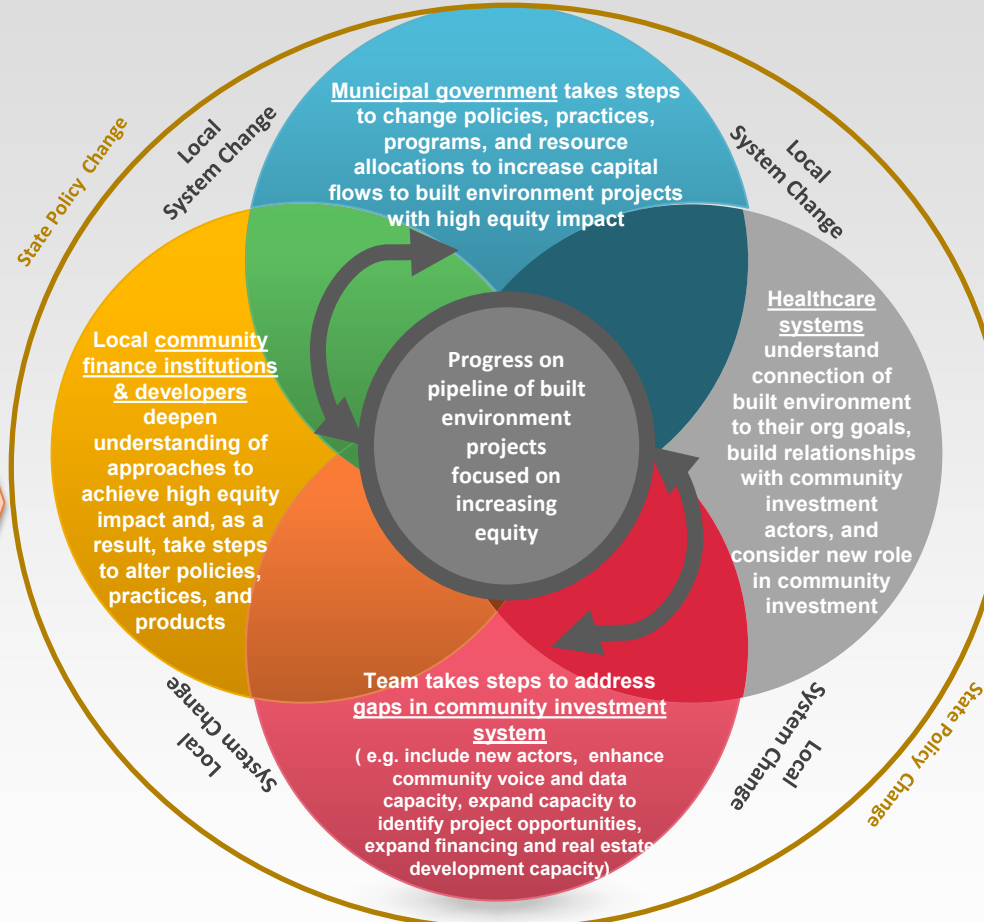
Long term goal

1 year outcome

Sustainable Change



City teams bring to Invest Health 2.0:

- Team has clear, focused vision linked to pipeline of financeable built environment projects w/ high equity impact potential
- Team intention to impact community investment system
- Team has foundation of cross sector collaboration
- Team reflects Invest Health mindset on connection of built environment/equity/health
- Team demonstrates capacity in Invest Health core practices (community engagement/data)

Invest Health Intervention

- \$30,000 for grant-related costs
- \$45,000 stipend for staff time
- Two learning convenings
- Customized support, coaching, technical assistance
- Access to Reinvestment Fund technical financing knowledge and CDFI network
